Fresh off a \$188 million renovation, the reinvigorated 1,634-room Sheraton Waikiki has reaffirmed its place as the leader in its class amongst Hawaii hotels. From the resort's beach level to the top of its 31-floor structure, the comprehensive renewal included new guest rooms and suites, redesigned public areas with new landscaping and pools, overhauled convention facilities, and new and exhilarating food and beverage outlets to a theme of "contemporary Hawaiian sophistication."

Be on the lookout for these exciting activities and developments at Sheraton Waikiki in 2012:

- § The evolution at RumFire ignites with a new menu concept called "social comfort food" by Chef Brett Villarmia. Known for its trendy interior, entertainment and "hot" cuisine, RumFire's new menu offers time-tested local comfort foods with a sizzling new twist called the "Pacific Rim of Fire."

- § Lovers will rejoice with the creation of a "Suite Life" package, including oceanfront one-bedroom suite accommodations, one bottle of sparkling wine, breakfast for two at Kai Market, dinner for two at Kai Market, a \$275 spa credit, catamaran ride for two, and complimentary access to the new Leahi Club Lounge located on the 30<sup>th</sup> floor.
- § In its pursuit of upholding the 30-20-20 green initiative (reduce waste by 30% and energy by 20% by 2020) Sheraton Waikiki will be installing a \$3 million photovoltaic rooftop panel system.

Malie, manufactured on Kauai, just recently opened its flagship store in The Royal Hawaiian late 2011.
- § Throughout the years, The Royal Hawaiian has collected many art pieces and in 2012, the resort will display its collection of art pieces as a new exhibit. The crowning jewel of this collection will be Herb Kane's last commissioned art piece of King Kamehameha sailing to O'ahu, which is displayed outside the historic Monarch Room.
- § As a testament to The Royal Hawaiian's focus on developing outstanding employees to continue the legacy of Hawaiian hospitality, Masako McCarter was honored at this year's Na Poe Paahana Awards as the Outstanding Lodging Employee of the Year along with several honorable mentions.
